

Passport Wallet



Passport Wallet

Ingredients:

Cut the following fabric:

- Outside Front $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Inside Back $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Wadding $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " (or iron-on pellon)
- Pocket 8" x $9\frac{3}{4}$ "
- Binding cut 2" x width of fabric (2"x40")

Method:

Sandwich the front, wadding (or pellon) and back fabric together (*just like you would a mini quilt*).

Quilt the fabric, embellish with some appliqué if you like

.....or if you are using iron-on pellon you can sandwich without quilting

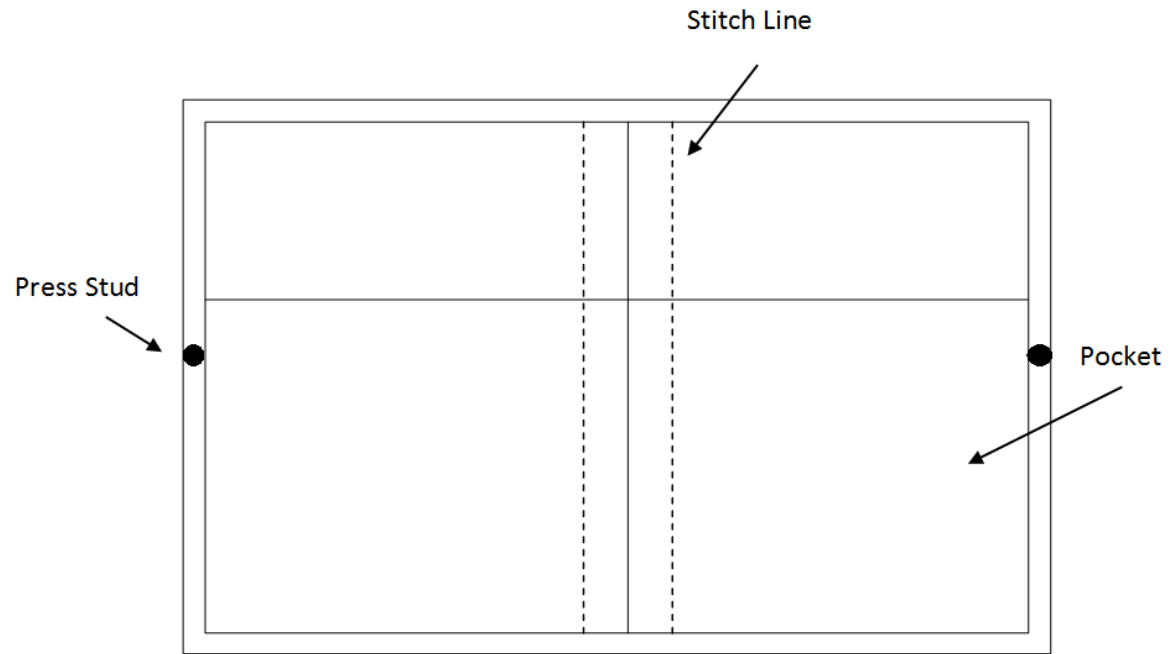
Now trim the 'mini quilt' to $9\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Iron the Pocket fabric in half wrong sides together to make a 4" x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " piece. Lay this on top of the inside of your mini quilt, and secure with a $\frac{1}{8}$ th seam around the outside edges.

Mark the centre of the open wallet and sew a line of stitching $\frac{1}{2}$ " each side of that centre line. A pen will fit in this little pocket.

Fold the binding fabric wrong sides together and press. Attach to the outside of the Passport wallet, as if you were binding a quilt, and hand stitch over to the inside.

If you like, sew a press stud to the inside centre of the wallet to help keep it shut.



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
